

## Sacred Fire COVID Safety procedures

1. Please bring masks and sanitizers.
2. Masks are required to be worn upon arrival and departure and anytime people are indoors or moving about closer than 6 feet.
3. When we are settled with seating outdoors with adequate spacing, masks can be removed.
4. Maintain a physical distance from each other. When this is not possible, please wear your masks.
5. There are hand sanitizers throughout the venue, please use it frequently.
6. The goal is to minimize transmitting virus from mouth/eyes/nose to your hands and onto surfaces and vice versa so be mindful of not touching your face – it's a great mindfulness practice. That is one of the reasons for frequent hand washing because we unconsciously touch our hands to our face.
7. There will be a maximum capacity allowed to the Center.
8. Upon arrival at registration, we'll do a health check to assess your condition with a short verbal COVID-19 questionnaire, a temperature check and an oximeter (blood oxygen saturation) check. If you do not pass the tests, in the interest of everyone's safety, unfortunately we will not be able to allow you to participate at this event and your registration will be refunded.
9. No smoking is permitted under the tent, except for the ceremonial team.
10. Members of your household and couples can sit together. Individuals, couples and groups will be seated six feet apart.
11. We ask that you not pass chocolate/snacks around the fire. Bring your own if you would like some.

**We ask that you respect these procedures. We can all do this and have a safe, heartfelt and connective time around the Fire!**
